Field trips will be hosted by Gaia at the Gaia Climate Center. Field trips will be anywhere from 1.5-3 hours in duration and include hands on activities. Students will learn about sustainability and recycling with Gaia staff. Field trips will be held in fall and spring, weather permitting, since students will be participating in outdoor activities. If teachers want their students to bring a lunch Gaia staff will need to know 48 hours in advance to block out time for a "Picnic in the Garden".

Clothes Drive

Gaia will be hosting an annual clothes and shoe drive at your school on an agreed upon day and time. Drop Box

Gaia will place a 4x4x7 drop box in an agreed upon area of the school. The drop box will be lime green and have all necessary permits, contact information, and Gaia business information visible. The drop box will be on a rotating schedule to get the contents cleaned out, and any necessary maintenance done, once a week. In the event of an emergency pickup (i.e. box is full, content outside box) then a Gaia operations team member will pick up the contents within 24 hrs. In the event the emergency pickup is after hours, on a holiday, or a weekend then the 24-hour time frame starts the beginning of the next business day. Gaia operations team members will always work to rectify any situations as quickly as possible!
